# 2010 Next Generation School Program Descriptions

## **Hangar Camp** (ages 7-10) July 19 - August 8

A half-day program (9am -1pm) for elementary aged theater lovers. Participants take part in acting, singing, dancing, puppetry, clowning and many more classes over the course of three weeks. Hangar Campers attend KIDDSTUFF performances and workshops with the directors and designers of the productions. The experience culminates with the campers showcasing their new skills on the Hangar Theatre's Niederkorn Stage on August 8!

We will also be offering an optional **Extended Creative Play** period between 1pm and 5pm daily for working families. Afternoons will be filled with more time for friends, fun and theatre. Camp Counselors will supervise afternoon activities full of imaginative and active play.

## **Hangar Teens** (ages 11-14) July 19 - August 28

Hangar Teens' outstanding theatre program offers a combination of excellent teaching, small classes, exciting direction, and quality performance experiences. Hangar Teens is centered on enhancing skill, encouraging cooperative work, and nurturing self confidence. Hangar Teens is an incredible opportunity for boys and girls ages 11 through 15 who are looking to take their theatre skills to the next level.

Hangar Teens is comprised of two three-week sessions. Students can participate in both sessions or choose just one.

### **Session 1: Acting Intensive July 19 - August 7**

A full day program where students receive the complete theatre experience by learning a full range of acting techniques that are applied to the rehearsal process and performance at the end of the session. Students take core acting, movement and voice classes along with workshops led by artists from the Hangar Theatre. All students participate in a production of The Odyssey 2.0, a new modern adaptation of the classic Greek myth created specifically for this program, performing on the Hangar Theatre's Niederkorn Stage on August 7!

*Tuition:* \$750

### **Session 2: Musical Theatre Performance August 9 - August 28**

A full day program where budding singer/actor/dancers get the opportunity to hone their abilities in class and then show them off as part of the Hangar's Kiddstuff season! A complete roster of training will be combined with rehearsal for the hilarious rock musical, School House Rock, Live! Junior, performing for the public on the Hangar Theatre's Niederkorn Stage, August 26-28.

## **Hangar Theatre Production Apprentices**

The Hangar Theatre offers Production Apprenticeships for High School Students giving them the opportunity to:

- Gain professional experience in technical theatre
- Meet and interact with top notch artists, actors, designers, and stage managers
- Help with load in and strike of Mainstage and KIDDSTUFF productions
- Be a part of Hangar Special Events, like opening night parties and company picnics
- Receive two comp tickets to any Hangar shows worked on
- Receive a discount on Next Generation School tuition

Production Apprentices may run Mainstage, KIDDSTUFF, or Wedge Productions. This could involve operating a followspot, assisting with costume quick changes, scene changes, or sound microphone adjustments. Former Production Apprentices become eligible for full-time Technical Apprenticeships or Production Internship positions with the Hangar upon graduation from high school. No experience is necessary, just a willingness to learn and become part of the team. Proper training is provided.

Production Apprenticeships are open to anyone 13 years of age or older who reside in the Ithaca area. The Hangar Theatre cannot be responsible for housing of minors. Production Apprenticeships are available for specific shows throughout the summer.
